

Thank you for your letter of 19 August 1998. I write to confirm that we discussed the case histories of 4 people who had experienced unfortunate results from having been recruited by the Friends of the Western Buddhist Order. On the basis of the symptomatology which was extremely similar I suggested they were suffering from serious adjustment disorders.

As a result of this indoctrination their states would in my opinion warrant the definition of ego dystonic sexual orientation (F66.1, ICD10) in that being heterosexual they were persuaded to participate in homosexual activities which they found distasteful, and as a result suffered identity crises, in two cases this sadly led to violent suicides.
